

## YOUTH PROTECTION ONLINE TRAINING INSTRUCTIONS

Youth Protection Training – the course will take approximately 20-30 minutes to take.

Note: BSA moved training to [my.scouting.org](http://my.scouting.org)

**Youth Protection Training:** New leaders are required to take Youth Protection training before submitting an application for registration. The certificate of completion for this training must be submitted at the time the application is made and before volunteer service with youth begins. Youth Protection Training must be completed every two years to remain current.

We also request that all parents take this training as well. If you are not signing up as a leader, no adult application is required to be filled out

Once you have logged in, select Youth Protection at the top of the page.

### The Following Information Displays:

#### Youth Protection Training Notice

You do not have to be a registered member or have a member ID to take Youth Protection training.

To take Youth Protection training:

1. Click the "New to Scouting" picture on right hand side.
2. On the next screen scroll down to Youth Protection Training and click Take Course.
3. When you complete the course, print a certificate of completion to submit with a volunteer application, or submit the certificate to the unit leader for processing at the local council.
4. When your volunteer application is approved, you will receive a BSA membership card, which includes your member ID number. After you receive your membership card, log onto MyScouting, click My Profile, and enter your member ID number. This links your Youth Protection training records, and any other MyScouting training records, to your BSA membership.

### Click "Take Course Online" (located under Boy Scout Leader)

Choose E-Learning and, under Youth Protection, choose which program you are in see example for "General"

E-Learning training courses are now available to take online on my.Scouting Tools. Training courses can be found by selecting the Home button in the upper left corner, then My Dashboard in the menu list. It will default to the My Training section which was also enhanced providing 4 new tab selections.

- **YPT** – displays the Youth Protection training courses available.
- **Training Center** – displays the Scouting programs containing the training courses applicable to the specific program.
- **Requirements** – displays training courses required to become position-trained for your current registered position(s).
- **Completions** – displays training courses that were completed.
